2024 Changes

HIP – All licensed hunters pursuing migratory game birds are required to register for HIP annually, either through the GO Outdoors Iowa app on their smartphones or through a link at www.iowadnr.gov/waterfowl. Non-licensed youth hunters are not required. See P 20

Federal E-Stamp – The Federal E-Stamp is now valid for the entire hunting season.

DEER – Providing measurement of main beam length of bucks was added to harvest report.

Antlerless quotas have changed in 12 counties. See p 8

HF2015

- General and antlerless (\$2.00) landowner tenant licenses are no longer season specific.
- Prior to this change, customers were required to choose a season.
- Can be used in any regular season, using the method of take for the season, until filled. (Youth and Disabled Season qualifications still apply).
- Customers will still need to choose a season for the two paid \$15.00 landowner tenant licenses.

The EO10 process for both the review of existing rule chapters and the reauthorization of rule chapters that will be retained includes public engagement with the opportunity for meaningful input throughout the process.

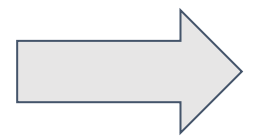

Water Quality Draft Rules

Water Quality Bureau staff continue to review current water quality rules and develop proposed changes to implement SD10. Please stay tuned for upcoming stakeholder

Foil Boards

Non Motorized foils should be registered with a boat type of Sail Only. Common Names-Wind Foil, Wake Foil Board, *Hydro Foil, Surf Foil

Motorized foils should be registered with a boat type of Personal Watercraft. Common Names-Efoil, E Hydrofoil (E=electric)

Correction

Motorized foils should be registered with a boat type of Other. Common Names-Efoil, E Hydrofoil (E=electric)

Iowa Code Definition:

“Personal watercraft” means a vessel, less than sixteen feet in length, which is propelled by a water jet pump or similar machinery

Bonding

What is a surety bond?

A financial mechanism that protects the customer in the event someone or an entity that claims ownership or financial interest in the vehicle or vessel.

Bonding

Bonding Rule Proposal

- Vehicle or Vessels with retail value of \$1000 or less AND 15 years or older
- Customer will still submit the Request Form and all of the requirements to the DNR
- DNR will determine the value of the vehicle
- If eligible, DNR will have an affidavit or standard of practice that ensures that the vehicle or vessel has not been stolen or embezzled. We are still working with law enforcement to determine this process.
